NOTES

1. Full Membership

Full Members of the TBA can:

- Visit the Clubhouse bar on Friday evenings and Sunday lunchtimes.
- Attend all of the Club's social functions.
- Join organised visits to places of interest and visits to other clubs.
- Book the Clubhouse for private functions (conditions and hire charges apply).
- Join the Social Committee and help organise events.
- Apply for a TBA Mooring on the River Dart at Totnes.
- Use the Club's dinghy and other boating facilities.
- Use the Clubhouse cloakrooms and showers at most times.
- Apply for the use of dinghy storage.
- Apply for summer or winter boat storage in the Boat Park.
- Join in any of the Club's boating activities and events.
- Park in the Club's car park when visiting the Club or using their boat.
- Use the club pontoon at Dartmouth weekends and Regatta week.
- Vote at the Club's Annual General Meeting which is held in November each year.
- Stand for membership of the Club's Executive Committee after one year.

2. Enrolment Fee

Full Members pay a "one-off" Enrolment Fee of £50 per family, plus the membership pro-rata subscription.

3. Annual Membership Subscription

The annual Membership Subscription of £84 is payable on 1st April each year. Members joining partway through a year will pay a pro-rata membership subscription in their first year.

4. Probationary Period

All new members serve a probationary period of three months. During this time applicants:

- Can make full use of facilities of the club and will be welcome at all events and activities,
- Must take the opportunity to meet as many members of the Executive Committee as possible,
- Should prove themselves suitable for TBA membership by taking an active part in Club activities,
- Must visit the club a minimum of twice a month during the 3-month period & sign the New Member's book on each occasion.

5. Membership Approval

After three months the Executive Committee will review the application. If refused, applicants have the right to appeal. Membership Subscription will be returned but not the enrolment fee.

6. Data Protection Act

Members' names, addresses, telephone numbers and details of their boat will be stored electronically for use on a computer. Please advise the Secretary if you do not agree to this.
